The Sanctuary, a program of Open Door Youth Services, provides temporary emergency shelter for youth ages 10-17 who are experiencing homelessness, family conflict, or unsafe living conditions. Our goal is to provide a safe and supportive space while helping youth and families work toward reunification whenever possible.

What We Offer:

- Safe, supervised shelter for up to 21 days.
- 24/7 support with trained staff always available.
- Individual, group, and family counseling.
- Assistance with education & life skills.
- Support in finding safe, long-term solutions.

Who Can Stay at The Sanctuary?

- Youth ages 10-17 who have no safe place to stay.
- Those experiencing family conflict, homelessness, or crisis situations.
- Youth in need of a structured and supportive environment.
